- > PennEast Evaluating an Alternate Route (parallel to the Power and Light Easement). In December, homeowners who are near the utility corridor received notice from PennEast that they were looking at a new route. For a map of this route, please see [dtpcap.org](http://dtpcap.org) or visit the Delaware Twp Municipal Building. According to PennEast, both routes are under review as a route for the pipeline.
  - > DTCAP is encouraging all new recipients of PennEast's request to survey their land to consider NOT ALLOWING ACCESS and educate yourself of your rights as landowners.
  - > DTCAP will hold another community forum on the PennEast project within the next few weeks. Date/location TBD. Stay Tuned.
  - > DTCAP is encouraging all to continue to write to your legislators and FERC to tell them that the alternate route is not the answer to this pipeline project. The impacts of any proposed pipeline remain the same. No Pipeline!
