Good afternoon,

PennEast Pipeline Company has made several upgrades to its website, www.penneastpipeline.com <<http://www.penneastpipeline.com/>>. Several stakeholders have suggested additional features that will help keep communities informed of project developments and industry standards.

More specifically, users are now able to compare prior pipeline routes to the current proposed preferred alternative route. Detailed maps of the current preferred alternative route have also been posted in PDF formats. All of the maps are accurate as January, 2015.

As we're still in the voluntary pre-filing process, the route remains under development and we will continue to refine the route as we receive feedback from landowners, gather more data, conduct surveys, and make additional decision. Going forward, we will post revised maps soon after they are submitted to the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC).

The site's main menu has also been updated to include a tab named "Regulatory" which provides easy access to all PennEast documents submitted to FERC.

Additionally, new videos have been posted under "Resources." These videos include a synopsis of PennEast's economic benefits during construction and ongoing operation, as well as an overview of interstate natural gas pipelines.
