

## **Warning: Know Your Legal Rights Before You Even Consider Signing Anything!**

Currently, representatives of PennEast are visiting individual homeowners in Delaware Township and neighboring communities seeking to convince them to sign legal consent forms to permit PennEast to survey their properties in preparation for PennEast's filing for approval of the project with the federal agency that regulates pipelines, the Federal Energy Regulatory Agency (FERC). **By signing these consent forms, you will be giving PennEast the right to enter your property to survey your land - this may involve damage to your property and impact your use of your own land in the future.** One preliminary step you can take right now is to post **No Trespassing** signs on your property. This step will offer some initial protection against representatives of Penn East repeatedly entering your property unannounced as many homeowners are currently experiencing.

**Come find out how the proposed PennEast Pipeline will impact You, Your Neighbors, and Your Community!**

PennEast Representatives will be at the September 29th meeting. Pipeline presentation/discussion begins at 8:00 p.m.

**Delaware Township Meeting on PennEast Pipeline Proposal to be held on Monday, September 29<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 p.m. at the Sergeantsville Fire Company banquet hall. Please join your community!**

If you have not yet heard, on August 12, 2014, PennEast Pipeline Company, LLC announced a joint project with several pipeline firms to construct a 100-mile pipeline to bring natural gas, produced through “fracking” in the Marcellus Shale region in Pennsylvania, to the Mid-Atlantic Region.

**Its currently proposed pipeline route will cut directly through Delaware Township – its residences, its preserved farmlands, its water table, its open space preservation sites dedicated to public use, and its scenic waterways!** The currently proposed pipeline route will begin in Luzerne County in northeastern Pennsylvania and end at Transco’s Trenton-Woodbury interconnection in New Jersey, travelling across the Delaware River and through Delaware Township, Kingwood Township, Lambertville, Hopewell, and Trenton.
