DELAWARE TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE #2016-17

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DELAWARE, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO AUTHORIZE AN APPROPRIATION AND EXPENDITURE FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$42,447.25, FOR THE PURCHASE OF A BOBCAT WOOD CHIPPER FOR THE DELAWARE TOWNSHIP ROAD DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Delaware, County of Hunterdon, and State of New Jersey as follows:

- Section 1. Delaware Township has a need to purchase a Bobcat Wood Chipper to help maintain the safety of the roads after a storm, when large branches and tree limbs fall on the roadways, and,
- Section 2. Delaware Township hereby authorizes an appropriation and expenditure from the Capital Improvement Fund in the amount of \$42,447.25 to purchase a Bobcat Wood Chipper for the Delaware Road Department; and,
- Section 3. Total amount to be expended for the purchase of a Bobcat Wood Chipper for the Delaware Township Road Department shall not exceed \$42,447.25; and,
- Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
