

DELAWARE TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE #2017-17

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DELAWARE, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO AUTHORIZE AN APPROPRIATION AND EXPENDITURE FROM RESERVE FOR THE PURCHASE OF OTHER RESERVES/SIDEWALKS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$30,000.00.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Delaware, County of Hunterdon, and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Delaware Township has a need to prepare a sidewalk development plan for the Village of Sergeantsville; and,

Section 2. Delaware Township hereby authorizes an appropriation and expenditure from Reserve for the Purchase of Other Reserves/Sidewalks in an amount not to exceed \$30,000.00, to direct our Township Engineer to prepare a comprehensive development plan for the construction of sidewalks in the Village of Sergeantsville; and,

Section 3. Total amount to be expended from Reserve for the Purchase of Other Reserves/Sidewalks shall not exceed \$30,000.00.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
