ORDINANCE #2011-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DELAWARE, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO AUTHORIZE AN APPROPRIATION AND EXPENDITURE FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,200.00 FOR THE PURCHASE OF BODY ARMOR VESTS FOR THE DELAWARE TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT. #2011-01

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Delaware, County of Hunterdon, and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Delaware Township has a need to replace police body armor on our current officers because the vests are outdated.

Section 2. Delaware Township has a need to purchase new body armor for our new police officers.

Section 3. Delaware Township hereby authorizes an appropriation and expenditure from the Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$4,200.00 for the purchase of police body armor.

Section 4. Total amount to be expended from the Capital Improvement Fund shall not exceed \$4,200.00.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
