## DELAWARE TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE #2011-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DELAWARE, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO AUTHORIZE AN APPROPRIATION AND EXPENDITURE FROM RESERVE FOR BUILDING CONSTRUCTION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,000.00 FOR RENOVATIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS TO THE DELAWARE TOWNSHIP POLICE BUILDING. #2011-04

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Delaware, County of Hunterdon, and State of New Jersey as follows:

- Section 1. Delaware Township has a need for a police building to provide police services to the residents of Delaware Township.
- Section 2. Delaware Township has a need to renovate and improve the building purchased by the Township Committee to meet New Jersey standards for police buildings.
- Section 3. Delaware Township hereby authorizes an appropriation and expenditure from Reserve for the Purchase of Building Construction in an amount not to exceed \$30,000.00.
- Section 4. Total amount to be expended from Reserve for the Purchase of Building Construction shall not exceed \$30,000.00.
- Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
