AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DELAWARE, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO AUTHORIZE AN EXPENDITURE AND APPROPRIATION FROM RESERVE FOR THE PURCHASE OF POLICE EQUIPMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF VARIOUS EQUIPMENT FOR THE DELAWARE TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$15,000.00. #2012-12

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Delaware, County of Hunterdon, and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Delaware Township has a need to purchase various equipment for the Police Department.

Section 2. Delaware Township hereby authorizes an appropriation and expenditure from Reserve for the Purchase of Police Equipment in an amount not to exceed \$15,000.00.

Section 3. Total amount to be expended from Reserve for the Purchase of Police Equipment shall not exceed \$15,000.00.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
