ORDINANCE #2012-16

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DELAWARE, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO AUTHORIZE AN EXPENDITURE AND APPROPRIATION FROM CAPITAL FUND BALANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$70,000.00 FOR MATERIALS AND LABOR FOR ROAD IMPROVEMENTS ON VARIOUS TOWNSHIP ROADS. #2012-16

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Delaware, County of Hunterdon, and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Delaware Township has a need to annually maintain Delaware Township roads.

Section 2. Delaware Township schedules maintenance on various roads throughout the Township.

Section 3. Delaware Township hereby authorizes an appropriation and expenditure for materials and labor for maintenance on various township roads from Capital Fund Balance in an amount not to exceed \$70,000.00.

Section 4. Total amount to be expended from Capital Fund Balance for labor and materials for township roads shall not exceed \$70,000.00.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
