

**DELAWARE TOWNSHIP**  
**ORDINANCE #2013-09**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DELAWARE, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO AUTHORIZE AN EXPENDITURE AND APPROPRIATION FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,000.00 FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF NEW GUTTERS FOR THE DELAWARE TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL BUILDING, FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A "KEY CARD" SYSTEM FOR THE GAS/FUEL TANKS AT THE DELAWARE TOWNSHIP ROAD DEPARTMENT, AND FOR THE PURCHASE OF SUPPLIES, MATERIALS AND LABOR, IF NEEDED, FOR REPAIRS TO THE DELAWARE TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL BUILDING IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$25,000.00. #2013-09

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Delaware, County of Hunterdon, and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Delaware Township has a need to purchase and install new gutters on the Township Building, to purchase and install a "key card" system for the Road Department, and for the purchase of supplies, materials and labor, if needed, to complete additional repairs to the Township Building.

Section 2. Delaware Township hereby authorizes an appropriation and expenditure from the Capital Improvement Fund in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00.

Section 3. Total amount to be expended from the Capital Improvement Fund for the purchase of supplies, materials and labor, if needed, for all the projects mentioned above shall not exceed \$25,000.00.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
