DELAWARE TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE #2014-08

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DELAWARE, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO AUTHORIZE AN EXPENDITURE AND APPROPRIATION FROM RESERVE FOR THE PURCHASE OF A FOUR-WHEEL DRIVE VEHICLE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000.00; AND TO AUTHORIZE AN EXPENDITURE AND APPROPRIATION FROM RESERVE FOR THE PURCHASE OF BUILDING CONSTRUCTION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$28,000.00 FOR SUPPLIES AND LABOR FOR BUILDING IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE DELAWARE TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL BUILDINGS. #2014-08

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Delaware, County of Hunterdon, and State of New Jersey as follows:

- Section 1. Delaware Township has a need to purchase various supplies and labor for improvements to the Delaware Township municipal buildings; and to maintain a fleet of police vehicles.
- Section 2. Delaware Township hereby authorizes an appropriation and expenditure from Reserve for the Purchase of Building Construction in the amount of \$28,000.00, and authorizes an appropriation and expenditure from Reserve for the Purchase of a Four-Wheel Drive Vehicle in the amount of \$5,000.00.
- Section 3. Total amount to be expended from the Reserve for the Purchase of Building Construction shall not exceed \$28,000.00.
- Section 4. Total amount to be expended from the Reserve for the Purchase of a Four-Wheel Drive Vehicle shall not exceed \$5,000.00.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
