

DELAWARE TOWNSHIP
ORDINANCE #2014-09

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF DELAWARE, COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO AUTHORIZE AN EXPENDITURE AND APPROPRIATION FROM RESERVE FOR THE PURCHASE OF ROAD DRAINAGE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$70,000.00 FOR ROAD REPAIR AND IMPROVEMENTS ON VARIOUS TOWNSHIP ROADS; AND AUTHORIZE AN EXPENDITURE AND APPROPRIATION FROM RESERVE FOR THE PURCHASE OF IMPROVEMENTS TO DILTS PARK IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,000.00 FOR LABOR AND MATERIALS FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE DILTS PARK #2014-09.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Delaware, County of Hunterdon, and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Delaware Township has a need to chip, tar and improve various roads in Delaware Township. Delaware Township hereby authorizes an appropriation and expenditure for labor and supplies for improvements to various township roads, in an amount not to exceed \$70,000.00.

Section 2. Delaware Township has a need to provide maintenance to the Dilts Park facilities. Delaware Township hereby authorizes an appropriation and expenditure to provide maintenance to Dilts Park in an amount not to exceed \$3,000.00.

Section 3. Total amount to be expended from Reserve for the Purchase of Road Drainage shall not exceed \$70,000.00.

Section 4. Total amount to be expended from Reserve for the Purchase of Improvements to Dilts Park shall not exceed \$3,000.00.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
