# **BOARD OF HEALTH NEW BUSINESS**

A. Septic Waiver, B17, L48 – 1 Biser Road – Bill Jupinka, PE addressed the board. This is a malfunctioning system to an existing three-bedroom home with no expansion with the use of an Advanced Treatment Unit. The house is empty. The current applicant will put the house on the market. There are 2 systems on the property both are saturated. The waiver is for a highwater table. Mike asked about the deed restrictions. The requirements for an Advanced Treatment Unit shall be adhered to. Carla said the county gets notified if the maintenance agreement is not renewed. Mike asked if there are streams in the area. Jorge asked the distance to the nearest well. Jorge asked about the size of this lot. It is 3.6 acres. The system is within the building setbacks.

Jorge Berkowitz made a motion to approve the waiver, Katie Hooven seconded the motion. All Voted Aye. Roll Call.

## HUNTERDON COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT – OLD BUSINESS

- A. Solid Waste N.O.V., B17, L18- 490 Sergeantsville Rd Carla said they are going to court for this violation.
- B. Suspect Kennel, B33, L18- 148 Lower Creek Road Carla had no update on this property. It's hard since it's a private home. She will contact the ACO. The dogs she licenses are not the dogs she is selling. She has a website.
- C. Illegal dumping, B7, L16 Q0073-31 Stone Signpost Road Carla said the state will enforce the clean-up. Solid waste issue and land use issue. The plum brook is very close. The state workers were furloughed for 2 weeks. The state will do enforcement against the companies who brought the dirt to the site. This will be a long term clean up.
- D. Septic Malfunction, B1, L9- 300 Old Croton Rd Carla said this is still an active malfunction. They are going to court.
- E. Solid Waste Notice of Violation B26, L21 66 Britton Road Carla said the renovation on this property has stopped. The debris is still sitting there.

Carla said most pools didn't open yet. Condo pools, community pools, camps, etc. Jorge asked Carla about nursing homes. They are still testing. They county helped with transport of testing. Many of the deaths were elderly in long term care places.

County had joint clinics at RVCC. The county now has two new inspectors for food inspections. They will help with all the restaurant inspections.

The county health dept. is very busy with septic's and home sales.
