a. Ordinance discussions/update – Land Disturbance and Zoning Officer Duties Administrative Office Klink stated that Chair Westlake had asked the Board to review the Land Disturbance draft for final recommendation. Administrative Officer Klink presented revisions proposed by Engineer Roseberry. The Board decided that the Engineer revisions created a list that would be very onerous for residents to present as a part of an application.

The Board returned to the original draft for further review. It was noted that there was a problem with the definition of Land Disturbance, as follows:

<u>Land Disturbance</u> - any activity involving the clearing, excavating, storing, grading, transporting, filling and any other activity which causes land to be exposed to the danger of erosion, but does not include agricultural practices.

Members felt that this definition could apply to any type of permit requested by the owner of a single family residence. The Board asked that the Ordinance Review Committee look at possible changes to this definition so that requests for permitted uses in a zone would not violate this definition.

## Zoning Officer Duties

The Board was reminded that this ordinance was given to the Board for its review. Administrative Officer Klink stated that Chair Westlake had been in touch with TC Attorney Dragan about this ordinance, but without a full conversation. The Board asked Liaisons with Township Committee to provide further instruction on how to proceed.

It was also recommended that research be done to find out what State provisions exist on these duties.
