Delaware Township Ordinance No. 2021 – 10

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A GREEN TEAM PURSUANT TO SUSTAINABLE NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Delaware, County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey, strives to save tax dollars, assure clean air and water, improve working and living environments, and build a community that is sustainable economically, environmentally, and socially; and

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Delaware wishes to build a model of government which benefits its residents with green community initiatives which are environmentally and economically sound, easy to replicate, and affordable to implement; and

WHEREAS, Sustainable New Jersey was formed as a certification program for municipalities in New Jersey that endeavor to "go green, save money and take steps to sustain their quality of life over the long term"; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A 40:56A-1 et. seq and Township Ordinance, the Township of Delaware created an Environmental Commission whose charge per said State law and Ordinance is to among other things protect, sustain, properly utilize and develop natural resources; and

WHEREAS, in an attempt to focus on green issues, the Township Committee of Delaware Township wishes to establish a Green Team as a sub-committee of the Environmental Commission to maximize the efficiency of the Environmental Commission and avoid overlap and duplication of efforts between the Green Team and Environmental Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Delaware as follows:

SECTION 1. Establishment

Current members of the Environmental Commission who are dedicated to the sustainability of the community and known as the Green Team, appointed by the Township Committee annually at their Re-Organization Meeting.

SECTION 2. Purpose

- a. To educate and encourage all Township employees, residents, and businesses to participate in green initiatives
- b. To collaborate with public and private green committees to ensure the replication of best practices and to ensure a coordinated effort within Delaware Township and with neighboring communities;
- c. Provide suggestions for further research and action to the Township Committee.
- d. To facilitate the successful completion of the requirements for certification of Sustainable Jersey and manage Delaware Township's participation in the Sustainable New Jersey program.

SECTION 3. Membership; Terms

- a. The Green Team will consist of members of the Delaware Township Environmental Commission, and can also have 1 Township Committee member, and 1 representative from the Department of Public Works.
- b. The regular members of the Green Team shall be persons who reside in Delaware Township, who hold no other elective or appointed office under the Township, and are members in good standing on the Environmental Commission.
- c. The Chairman of the Environmental Commission shall serve as Chairman and presiding officer.
- d. The Full Term of office for each regular member shall coincide with the term on the Environmental Commission.

- e. A vacancy occurring otherwise than by an expiration of a term shall be filled for the unexpired term only.
- f. The Township Committee may remove any member for cause, on written charges served upon the member and after a hearing thereon at which the member shall be entitled to be heard in person or by counsel.

SECTION 4. If any sentence, section, clause, or other portion of this ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance, shall for any reason be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or repeal the remainder of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as required by law.

Delaware Township Ordinance No. 2021 – 11

An Ordinance by The Township of Delaware in Hunterdon County, New Jersey Amending Section 7-3 Of The Delaware Township Municipal Code to Include Permit Parking in Designated Areas

WHEREAS, residents of Delaware Township have been negatively impacted by non-resident parking in certain residential communities;

WHEREAS, certain communities have Home Owner's Associations (HOA) that wish to seasonally regulate parking within their community for the general health safety and wellbeing of its residents;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Delaware in Hunterdon County, State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. Section 7-3 of the Delaware Township Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding a new paragraph (10) entitled 7-3-10 Parking by Permit Only which states as follows: "No person shall park a vehicle upon Palmier Road, or any part thereof, from April 1 through and including October 31 each year without first obtaining a parking permit issued through the HOA and visibly displayed within the vehicle. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this chapter shall be liable to a penalty of \$50.00"
- 2. Any article, section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or other provision of the Delaware Township Code that is inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- 3. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subsection, clause, or provision so adjudged, and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.
- 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication and filing with the Hunterdon County Planning Board, and as otherwise provided for by law.
